General Information

Eligibility

Any child entering 1st – 6th grades in the fall of 2018 is eligible to enroll. Kid's University students are expected to possess a level of maturity required of this type of program. Students who display inappropriate classroom behavior may be removed from the program without a refund. Please notify us of any special needs your child may have so that we can accommodate them.

Registration and Tuition

A registration form must be completed and returned to UAM's Kids' University for each child by 11:30 am on Friday, June 22. The tuition fee of \$100 includes a t-shirt and all supplies. Space in the program will be filled on a first come, first served basis with a paid and completed registration form. Since space is limited, early registration is encouraged.

Kids' University Scholarships

A limited number of scholarships are available. To apply, parents must complete a scholarship application. Income documentation must accompany the child's Kids' University registration and scholarship application forms.
